Colorado Division of Gaming released March Sports Betting Figures

Lakewood, Colo. - April 28, 2023 - The Colorado Division of Gaming (part of the Colorado Department of Revenue (CDOR)) released the March 2023 monthly sports betting figures.

Total Handle: March 2023	\$494,440,209.59 (16.3% increase from February 2023)	Represents a 2.21% decrease from the total handle for March 2022 (\$505,611,080.13)

Total Taxes: March 2023	\$3,103,024.26 (146.79% increase from February 2023)	
Total Taxes: February 2023	\$1,257,331.61	Represents a 136.31% increase from the total taxes for March 2022 (\$1,313,095.73)
Fiscal Year Wagers: To Date including March 2023	\$4,062,839,043.03	Represents a 8.35% increase from the FYTD Wagers from March 2022 (\$3,749,743,663.00)
Fiscal Year Taxes To Date including March 2023	\$20,346,558.74	Represents a 119.18% increase from the FYTD Taxes from March 2022 (\$9,282,965.42)
