Welcome and Introductions

Patrick Maroney, Director, opened the meeting and began by thanking the working group members for their time and the public for their attendance. Each working group member and the public introduced themselves. Director Maroney stated that only working group members are allowed to participate in this discussion and that public comment will be allowed at the end of the meeting.

Subgroup Recommendations

- Recommendation 15-01 – Self Dispensing – This recommendation is regarding Self Dispensing Machines in retail establishments for on-premise consumption. Director Maroney read through the draft rule: 47-908 - Automatic and Electronic Dispensing Systems. Revisions allow a patron at an on-premise location to show ID, and present payment to enable the establishment to load the system for that individual which would allow automatic dispensing of either 32 ounces of beer, 14 ounces of wine or 2 ounces of spirituous liquor. The working group had a short discussion and made a couple of very small changes to the draft language.

- Recommendation 15-02 – Manufacturer Sales Rooms – This applies to Rule 47-428 - Manufacturer Sales Rooms. Director Maroney explained that when reviewing the rules, he discovered two other rules where this applies and added 47-400 – Licensed Breweries and 47-412 – Wholesale Warehouse or Branch Houses to the review. The

Working Group had a short discussion regarding the revisions. The Division will incorporate the changes discussed into the draft rules.

- Recommendation 15-03 – Powdered Alcohol – Regulations 47-940 – Powdered Alcohol – Packaging and Labeling and 47-942 – Powdered Alcohol Regulation. The following formal statement was written in the recommendation: “Several subcommittee members voiced concern that the rule does not address all their concerns with Powdered Alcohol, but all members understand the limitations of the Division and the legal ability to restrict Powdered Alcohol beyond that of the spirituous liquor.” The working group proceeded with a short discussion mostly regarding labeling and packaging requirements.

The above recommendations will be presented to the Liquor Rules Working Group which convenes tomorrow.

Public Comment

Director Maroney asked for any public comment, nobody came forward.

The meeting was adjourned.
