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Rulemaking Requirements - Tangible Educational Resource

HB21-1317 requires the State Licensing Authority to create a tangible educational resource regarding the use of regulated marijuana concentrate. The educational resource must be completed by January 1, 2022. The educational resource must provide information as determined by rule and education, including but not limited to:

- Examples of visual representation of a serving size recommended for each type of concentrate;
- Risks and precautions;
- Other statutory and regulatory labeling requirements mandated on marijuana products; and
- A notice describing the penalties associated with diversion.

Discussion Items - Tangible Educational Resource

1. What are real-life examples that can generally be referenced to visually represent a potential serving size? (e.g. how does it compare to the size of a tic-tac?)
2. What health or safety risks should be identified for consumers of concentrates?
3. What precautions for the consumption of concentrates should be identified? (e.g. general ingredients that may be used such as solvents, proper consumption techniques)
4. Identification of the current warning statements in the Rule 3-1000 series for the resource.

Rulemaking Requirements - Promoting Consumer Health & Awareness

HB21-1317 requires the State Licensing Authority to establish requirements for Medical and Retail Marijuana Concentrate to promote consumer health and awareness. Effective January 1, 2023, requirements for Medical and Retail Concentrate to promote consumer health and awareness, shall include:

- A recommended serving size;
- Visual representation of one recommended serving;
- Labeling requirements; and
- May include a measuring device that can be used to measure one recommended serving.

Discussion Items - Consumer Health & Awareness

1. What considerations or proposed requirements should be included in the determination of a recommended serving size?
2. What minimum standards or requirements can be identified to ensure consumers receive a visual representation of a serving size?
3. What are the additional labeling requirements that promote consumer health and awareness for concentrates that are not currently included on a label?
