In addition to the Master Contact, it may be necessary to establish a User Administrator for one or more of the account types; which is the responsibility of the Master Contact. A User Administrator will have the ability to set up additional Revenue Online users and establish their access level. The Business Account may only have *one* Master Contact established, but may grant access to many individuals to be a User Administrator or have access to the Revenue Online accounts.
