Ms. Rouze stated that the Board currently has no President or Vice-Presidents. She further informed all in attendance of the following:

- Ms. Carrie Baumgart and Mr. Luke Walch's terms ended in June. Ms. Baumgart served two terms and Mr. Walch did not seek reappointment.

There is a provision in the state Constitution that allows incumbent members to continue their duties until they are reappointed or until their successors become qualified.

Ms. Charla Berens is authorized to continue to serve on the Board until her reappointment by the Governor. Ms. Berens' term is extended until such appointment.

Ms. Rouze turned the floor over to Sr. Assistant Attorney General, Ms. Sarah Killeen, to conduct the statutorily required election of officers to the Board for fiscal year 2023.

Ms. Killeen stated that pursuant to section 44-20-104(2) C.R.S., Board officers shall be elected for President, 1st Vice-President and 2nd Vice-President each year during the month of July. Ms. Killeen explained the election process and conducted the elections.

COMPLAINT INVESTIGATIONS REPORT

Mr. Opeka presented the following to the Board:

Statistical Reporting - Mr. Opeka informed the Board that we ended May with 293 cases, 123 new cases were opened, and 122 cases were closed, giving the Division a balance of 294 open cases. There were 191 background inquiries performed.

Public Comment - Mr. Cardella of CIADA congratulated the newly elected officers of the Board and thanked them for their service.

New Business - Ms. Chandler asked if there had been any new developments with Carvana.

Ms. Rouze stated that Carvana is licensed in Colorado.

The recent televised events regarding Carvana were related to sales that took place in Arizona and Texas, of which we have no jurisdiction and to do so would require statutory change, which could be addressed during the next legislative session.

The issue with Tesla regarding their self-driving feature was discussed and Tesla indicated that they remove this feature before sending to auction.

Mr. Shaughnessy stated that the issues with Tesla appear to be timing issues and that they are working to provide clarity.

The meeting of the Motor Vehicle Dealer Board was adjourned at 10:24 a.m.
