President, John Linton, opened the meeting of July 8, 2020 at 9:30 a.m. Mr. Linton turned the floor over to Executive Secretary, Chris Rouze.

#### AGENDA REVIEW AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

Ms. Rouze informed the Board there were no changes to the agenda as posted. Mr. Porter will not be in attendance today.

Ms. Rouze stated that the appointment or reappointment of Board members is forthcoming. She went on to say that a provision was found in the State Constitution and also in case law that allows incumbent Board members to continue their duties until they are reappointed or until their successors become qualified.

The Exceptions hearing will follow the regularly scheduled Board meeting next month on August 18, 2020 at 1:00 p.m. Conflicts Counsel will be available for the hearing. In addition, the emergency rules that were put in place will expire in August, which requires additional rulemaking be done in regard to the pandemic and the public health orders.

Ms. Rouze turned the floor over to Senior Assistant Attorney General, Brad Jones to conduct the Board elections pursuant to section 44-20-104(2).
