Affidavit of Probable Cause:

- **Off-Road Automotive, DL #44485** - Motion that the Board find probable cause based upon the Affidavit of Probable Cause presented to the Board today respective to Off-Road Automotive, Dealer License #44485; and that the Colorado Motor Vehicle Dealer Board summarily suspend their motor vehicle dealer license in accordance with C.R.S. 24-4-104 as they have engaged in deliberate and willful acts and their conduct poses a threat to the public health, safety and welfare - passed unanimously.
