April	Limits on the amount of alcohol an on-premises retailer can purchase from an off-premises retailer	<ul> <li>What is the history of this statute and why does it exist in the first place?</li> <li>What type of product is typically bought from LQ stores?</li> </ul>
May	<ul> <li>Making to-go drinks/bottles permanent</li> <li>Standardize container definitions</li> </ul>
