## **Colorado Division of Gaming released July Sports Betting Figures**

Lakewood, Colo. - September 12, 2023 - The Colorado Division of Gaming (part of the Colorado Department of Revenue (CDOR)) released the July 2023 monthly sports betting figures.

Total Taxes: July 2023	\$1,778,766.59 (302.48% increase from June 2023)	Represents a 62.86% increase from July 2022 (\$1,092,181.63)
Total Taxes: June 2023	\$441,950.58	
Fiscal Year Wagers: To Date including July 2023	\$281,110,490.36	Represents a 8.78% increase from the FYTD Wagers from July 2022 (\$258,414,807.73)
Fiscal Year Taxes To Date including July 2023	\$1,778,766.59	Represents a 62.86% increase from the FYTD Taxes from July 2022 (\$1,092,181.63)
