^{*} The proposed rule revisions to implement HB 23-1279 and SB 23-199 were adopted on an emergency basis on August 8, 2023 and have not been substantively changed in the draft rules to be discussed by the work group, with the exception of Rule 5-105, which seeks to align online payment processing requirements for Medical Marijuana Stores with Retail Marijuana Store and Accelerator Store Requirements.
