Colorado Division of Gaming released Record Breaking Sports Betting Figures for November

Lakewood - Dec. 29, 2023 - The Colorado Division of Gaming (part of the Colorado Department of Revenue (CDOR)) released record breaking monthly sports betting figures for November 2023. \$608+ million is the highest amount of handle in a given month since the inception of sports betting in May 2020 as well as the first time the monthly handle has exceeded \$600 million.

Fiscal Year Taxes To Date including November 2023	\$11,541,296.57	Represents a 6.71% increase from the FYTD Taxes from November 2022 (\$10,816,034.54)
