Taxes Collected on Sports Betting Show Increase in Fiscal Year Taxes To Date Collected Over May 2023

Lakewood - June 27, 2024 - The Colorado Division of Gaming, part of the Colorado Department of Revenue (CDOR), released the monthly sports betting figures for May 2024. Fiscal Year Taxes To Date show a 13.82% increase over May 2023. Here are the figures:
