• Future Bets (placed before game day): \$17,126,712.12

• Win percentage: 14.38%

• 2023 Figures:

o Total handle: \$37,961,228 (7% decrease over 2022)

Online wagers: \$36,313,016Retail wagers: \$1,648,212

o Game Day Bets: \$23,993,086

• Future Bets (placed before game day): \$13,966,086

• Win percentage: 9.62%
