Colorado Division of Gaming Monthly Figures Show a 12% Increase in Wagers for Fiscal Year To Date

Taxes Collected on Sports Betting Also Increased by 12% for Fiscal Year To Date

Lakewood - November 21, 2024 - New monthly figures show a double-digit increase in Fiscal Year To Date Taxes and Wagers.

The Colorado Department of Revenue, Division of Gaming’s October 2024 figures show Fiscal Year To Date Wagers at \$1,856,920,625.15, an increase of 12.21% from October 2023, and Fiscal Year To Date Taxes collected at \$11,269,915.76, an increase of 12.12% from October 2023.
