

Amended Emergency Regulation 44-20-402(17)-E:

DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE Motor Vehicle Dealer Board
DEALING IN POWERSPORTS VEHICLES 1 CCR 205-2

Statutory Authority: Colorado Revised Statutes, Sections 44-20-401, 44-20-402, 44-20-403, 44-20-404, 44-20-408, and 44-20-119.

Basis and Purpose: To provide the ability to conduct powersports vehicle sales during the COVID-19 pandemic while complying with Executive Order D 2020 044 dated April 26, 2020, Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment's Public Health Order 20-28 dated April 26, 2020, and other guidance issued by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC).

EMERGENCY REGULATION 44-20-402(17)-E: Powersports Vehicle Transactions During COVID-19 Pandemic

During the effective period of Colorado Public Health Order 20-28, dated April 26, 2020, licensed dealers may complete sales transactions under the conditions and in the manner described below:

- a. Dealerships shall comply with the provisions of Public Health Order 20-28 (including all appendixes), unless the local county in which a specific dealer location is located has received a variance from the State as provided under Section V of Colorado Public Health Order 20-28.
- b. Dealerships shall comply with any public health standards and orders issued by a county or municipality in which each dealership location is located.

As used in this emergency regulation, "dealers" refers to either licensed powersports vehicle dealers or licensed used powersports vehicle dealers.

The Board hereby incorporates as part of Emergency Regulation 44-20-402(17)-E of the Colorado Motor Vehicle Dealer Board rules under 1 C.C.R. 205-2 the following public health order by reference:

(1) Public Health Order *20-28 Safer At Home* dated April 26, 2020 issued by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, 4300 Cherry Creek Drive South, Denver, CO 80246. This rule does not include any later amendments or editions of the Public Health Order 20-28 *Safer At Home*.
