DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE Motor Vehicle Dealer Board DEALING IN MOTOR VEHICLES 1 CCR 205-1

Statutory Authority: Colorado Revised Statutes, Sections 44-20-101, 44-20-102, 44-20-103, 44-20-104(3)(a), 44-20-108, and 44-20-120.

Basis and Purpose: To provide the ability to conduct motor vehicle sales online or by appointment during the COVID-19 pandemic while complying with Colorado Public Health Order 20-24 and guidance from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment for social distancing.

<u>EMERGENCY REGULATION 44-20-102(22)-E:</u> ONLINE TRANSACTIONS AND IN-PERSON INTERACTIONS

DURING THE EFFECTIVE PERIOD OF COLORADO PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER 20-24, MOST RECENTLY UPDATED MARCH 27, 2020, LICENSED DEALERS MAY COMPLETE SALES TRANSACTIONS UNDER THE CONDITIONS AND IN THE MANNER DESCRIBED BELOW:

- a. Dealership sales departments and showrooms will not be open to the general public. Dealers may conduct transactions online, in their licensed location by appointment only, or remotely, provided that the Social Distancing Requirements, as defined in Section III.F of Colorado Public Health Order 20-24, are strictly adhered to.
- b. Deliveries and in-person interactions may only be conducted in the following settings:
 - OUTSIDE ON DEALERSHIP PROPERTY PROVIDED THAT THE SOCIAL DISTANCING REQUIREMENTS, AS DEFINED IN SECTION III.F OF COLORADO PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER 20-24, ARE STRICTLY ADHERED TO.
 - 2. IN A SERVICE BAY CLEANED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS FOR CRITICAL BUSINESSES PROVIDED IN SECTION III.C OF COLORADO PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER 20-24,
 - 3. IN A DESIGNATED ROOM AT THE DEALERSHIP WHICH HAS BEEN CLEANED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS FOR CRITICAL BUSINESSES PROVIDED IN SECTION III.C OF COLORADO PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER 20-24, OR
 - 4. At the customer's residence or place of business provided that the Social Distancing Requirements, as defined in Section III.F of Colorado Public Health Order 20-24, are strictly adhered to.
- **C.** AS USED IN THIS EMERGENCY REGULATION, "DEALERS" REFERS TO EITHER LICENSED MOTOR VEHICLE DEALERS OR LICENSED USED MOTOR VEHICLE DEALERS.

THE BOARD HEREBY INCORPORATES AS PART OF EMERGENCY REGULATION 44-20-102(22)-E OF THE COLORADO MOTOR VEHICLE DEALER BOARD RULES UNDER 1 C.C.R. 205-1 THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER BY REFERENCE:

(1) Second Updated Public Health Order 20-24 Implementing Stay At Home Requirements dated March 27, 2020 issued by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, 4300 Cherry Creek Drive South, Denver, CO 80246. This rule does not include any later amendments or editions of the Second Updated Public Health Order 20-24 Implementing Stay At Home Requirements.
