First of all, thank you to the task force for all its hard and diligent work, as well as approving Proposal 25.

As an individual consumer, I am in favor of the proposal as:

- it will enhance the dining experience in most restaurants
- usually it is used for special occasions, so that people like me can bring in their own special bottle.
- during discussions, several LAG members noted that in other states, experience demonstrates that customers rarely use this opportunity.
- control over these 'corked' bottles would be the same as for restaurant wine service, since it is only available to licensed facilities.
- it will bring Colorado up to national standards, with such states as CA and NY. Tourists will appreciate this consistency.

-it will give restaurant owners full flexibility to NOT allow this in their business, if they so desire.
