I appreciate all the consideration, discussion and work the subgroup has had on this topic.

Comment: re bullet point 2 (750ml).

If a customer is celebrating a special event (e.g. wedding anniversary, birthday) and say the party size is 6-8 people, 750ml will be insufficient for the guests.

I suggest that the language be changed to up to 3 bottles of 750ml (or equivalent), at the discretion of the policy of the licensee establishment.
