**SPORTS BETTING INDUSTRY BULLETIN 13**

**RE: Rule 3.3, Renewal/Reissuance requirements of Licensees**

The Division is providing this industry bulletin to give further guidance regarding Renewal and Reissuance licensing requirements of Sports Betting Licenses, pursuant to 1 C.C.R. 207-2 and Sports Betting Rule 3.3(2).

This Industry Bulletin is provided to address the large volume of late Sports Betting License Renewal/Reissuance (renewal) applications that the Colorado Division of Gaming (Division) has been receiving from some Licensees in the Sports Betting Industry. The industry's active participation in the license renewal process is crucial to ensuring the honesty and integrity of the Sports Betting Industry. The requirements of renewal deadlines are published in Rule 3.3. A summary of Rule 3.3 is also listed below.

It is the responsibility of the Licensee to know and follow their renewal dates, deadlines, and rules. Please ensure that you submit the necessary paperwork to renew your Sports Betting License, on time or early. Timely submitting of your renewal application will ensure that the Division can quickly and thoroughly review and respond to your renewal request.

Per Rule 3.3, renewal applications for sports betting operator licenses, internet sports betting operator licenses, vendor major licenses, and vendor minor licenses must be received by the Division 120 days before the expiration of the current License. See Sports Betting Regulation 3.3(2), 1 C.C.R. 207-2.

Failure to submit the appropriate renewal paperwork prior to the 120-day period, could cause your license to become inactive. This could potentially lead to the Division seeking enforcement action against you and/or your license. It's crucial to avoid this situation by starting the renewal process on time.
