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LED - 2022 Liquor Rules Working Group

Dear Liquor Stakeholders,

The Division is grateful for the robust and thoughtful discussions during this year's rulemaking sessions. Thank you to everyone for your continued engagement in the rulemaking process.

In the work group meeting scheduled for August 23, 2022 we plan on addressing the following regulations:

- 47-310 - Application - General Provisions
- 47-405 - Festival Permit

- 47-605 - Responsible Alcohol Beverage Vendor and Permitted Tastings by Retail Liquor Stores and Liquor-Licensed Drugstores
- 47-606 - Disciplinary and Denial Process for State Licensing Authority
- 47-1000 - Qualifications for Special Event Permit
- 47-1002 - Application for Special Event Permit
- 47-1004 - Special Event Permit - Non-transferable
- 47-1006 - Special Event Permit - Application on School Property
- 47-1008 - Special Event Permit - Private Residence: Multiple Use
- 47-1010 - Special Event Permit - Possession of Beverages
- 47-1012 - Special Event Permit - Permitted Age of Servers
- 47-1014 - Special Event Permit - Discipline Against Special Event Permittees and Special Event Festival Licensees - Suspension or Revocation of Permit - Summary Suspension
- 47-1016 - Special Event Permittee - Purchase and Storage of Alcohol Beverages
- 47-1018 - Special Event Permittee - Supplier Financial Assistance
- 47-1020 - Alcohol Beverage Donations

The Division is discussing language and conducting marketplace research regarding regulation 47-906 on Container Size. We may send further

communications prior to the next work group session; however, the Division may also elect to wait for federal rulemaking to conclude and address rule 47-906 in the next rulemaking cycle.
