TIME SENSITIVE INFORMATION FROM THE MARIJUANA ENFORCEMENT DIVISION REGARDING RFID TAG PROVISIONING THROUGH THE MARIJUANA INVENTORY TRACKING SOLUTION

Dear MED Medical Marijuana Business Licensee:

The Marijuana Enforcement Division (the "Division") is closely monitoring the roll out of the Marijuana Inventory Tracking Solution. The Division recognizes that some licensees have experienced challenges with the RFID tag provisioning process. The introduction of RFID tags to your marijuana inventory is a critical step in becoming fully functional in the Marijuana Inventory Tracking Solution. As a result of these challenges, the Division will be granting an extension of time to medical marijuana licensees to become fully functional in the Marijuana Inventory Tracking Solution, provided they have completed the steps listed below:

This extension of time will only apply to Medical Marijuana licensees who, upon demand, can provide documentation evidencing that the licensee has:

- (1) completed the required the Marijuana Inventory Tracking Solution training in a timely manner;
- (2) ordered enough RFID tags for all plants in its possession by midnight on December 31, 2013; and
- (3) has entered all required information in the Marijuana Inventory Tracking Solution, including all employees, strains and inventory, other than tagging plants and medical marijuana products in the Marijuana Inventory Tracking Solution, by midnight on December 31, 2013.

A licensee must meet all of the above criteria, without exception, to be granted an extension of time to place RFID tags on all plants and medical marijuana products within its inventory. Meeting these requirements will render the licensee fully functional in the Marijuana Inventory Tracking Solution.

If a licensee maintains documentation evidencing that it meets all of the above criteria, the Division will grant it an extension of time to become fully compliant with the Marijuana Inventory Tracking Solution and the licensee may continue to operate after December 31, 2013. The extension of time shall also be contingent upon a licensee continuing to update all of the data it can within the Marijuana Inventory Tracking Solution in a timely manner. The extension of time shall expire, without exception, 4 calendar days after a licensee receives its shipment of RFID tags ordered through the Marijuana Inventory Tracking Solution. No extension shall be in effect beyond January 31, 2014. All licensees must be fully functional in the Marijuana Inventory Tracking Solution and compliant with all relevant rules and procedures, including the use of transportation manifests at that time.

This extension shall not apply to any Retail Marijuana License. In order to exercise any of the privileges granted by a Retail Marijuana License, the licensee must be fully function in the Marijuana Inventory Tracking Solution and compliant with all relevant rules and procedures, including the use of RFID tags and transport manifests.
