The Colorado Limited Gaming Control Commission assesses taxes based on adjusted gross proceeds (AGP).

The tax rates for period ending June 30, 2026 are:

3% on AGP from charitable gaming .25% on amounts up to \$2 million 2% on amounts over \$2 million and up to \$5 million 9% on amounts over \$5 million and up to \$8 million 11% on amounts over \$8 million and up to \$10 million 16% on amounts over \$10 million and up to \$13 million 20% on amounts over \$13 million

The tax rates for year ending June 30, 2026 are the same as they were for year ending June 30, 2025.

Re: July 2025 Gaming Fund Financial Statement Presentation

Following are highlights from the Gaming Fund financial statements ending July 31, 2025.

Statement of Revenues, Expenditures, and Changes in Fund Balance

Gaming tax revenues have increased by \$581,590 or 9.9% over last year. Total Revenues for the Limited Gaming Fund as of July 31 were \$6,611,543, a 1.5% increase compared to July 2024.

Total expenditures for the period ending July 2025 were approximately \$1.7 million. This represents a 6.5% increase over last year. The main reason for the increase is in the Salaries and Benefits line, which increased by \$60,523 or 6.9% over last year. There was an 5.7% increase in the average of health, dental and life expenditures this fiscal year and we had six more employees in July of this year compared to July of last year. The PERA Direct Distribution expenditure is \$10,353 more this fiscal year compared to last fiscal year. The OIT Purchased Services line increased by \$30,148 or 51.2% over last year. This was expected, as the appropriation is \$361,772 higher than it was in fiscal year 2025.

The excess of total revenues over expenditures was \$4,880,176. This is a 0.1% decrease over last year and represents the amount we could distribute as of July 31.

Next, as you are aware from my cover letter, we are only required to prepare a Statement of Revenues and Expenditures. For those of you who were here last year, you may recall that since the inception of the statewide financial system known as CORE, the State now takes a long time to close the fiscal year. Beginning balances do not roll into the next fiscal year until the State closes the previous fiscal year. Therefore, we will not be able to prepare a balance sheet until the State closes. Regarding the budget, we should be able to prepare this statement with September's financial statements.

Re: July 2025 Sports Betting Fund Financial Statements

Following are highlights from the Sports Betting Fund financial statements ending July 31, 2025.

Statement of Revenues, Expenditures, and Changes in Fund Balance

Current fiscal year Sports Betting Tax revenue was \$2,715,492, which is an increase of \$345,762, or about 15%, over the prior fiscal year. The current fiscal year increase in Sports Betting Tax revenue is due in part to the year over year increase in Net Sports Betting Proceeds of 12%.

Total Sports Betting Fund revenues through July 2025 decreased by \$155,295 or 4% over July 2024. This is due in part to the year over year decrease in Sports Betting Operation Fees of \$503,100.

Total Sports Betting Fund expenditures through July 2025 were \$368,482. This is an increase of about 10% over July 2024. The increase is due primarily to the increase in salaries and benefits.

Sports Betting Fund Distribution as outlined in CRS 44-30-1509(2)

- First, pay all ongoing expenses related to the administration of sports betting
- Second, transfer an amount equal to six percent of the full fiscal year sports betting tax revenues, or six percent of twenty-nine million dollars, whichever is less, to the wagering revenue recipients hold-harmless fund, referred to as the "hold-harmless fund"
- Third, transfer all remaining unexpended and unencumbered money in the fund to the water plan implementation cash fund






Sports Betting Distribution Fiscal Year 2025 vs 2024

This notice is to inform the Commission of funding appropriation changes made to the FY 2025-26 Division of Gaming budget during the first quarter of the fiscal year by the Department of Revenue.

Limited Gaming

The approved budget of \$24,089,845 increased to \$24,093,541 for a total change of \$3,696. During the first quarter of the fiscal year, the indirect cost assessment appropriation and central appropriation changes, including a decrease of \$50 and an increase of \$3,696 respectively, were executed. Details of those changes follow:
