Hello,

I won't be able to make the meeting, but this seems like a major encroachment on retail licenses. 1.5L of wine, a Liter of Spirits, up to a 12 pack of beer? Up to 50% of their total revenue can be derived from delivery of alcohol? I would propose something more reasonable like 1 drink (12oz of beer, 5oz of wine, 2 oz of Spirits) per dish/serving of food, and a much smaller portion of their revenue, and allows them to offer craft cocktail offerings alongside their food rather than just delivering Liter sized bottles of spirits. I don't have restaurant experience, so I don't have a good grip on what would be reasonable to expect from alcohol delivery, but I would expect it to be much closer to the 5%-10% range for a business that is actually primarily operating as a restaurant and not an alcohol delivery service.
