Request for stakeholder engagement.

Currently the Motor Vehicle Dealer Board has delegated to the Executive Secretary the ability to issue a dealer license when:

- a. The Executive Secretary, after due diligence, has determined that the guidelines set by the Board for the following factors have all been met, allowing, in the exercise of informed discretion, for minor deviations from the noted thresholds:
 - (1) Reasonably liquid net worth of \$100,000.00.
 - (2) 701 or higher Experian Vantage credit score.
 - (3) No unpaid Colorado tax obligations, Federal tax obligations, and/or tax obligations from another jurisdiction within or outside of Colorado, and no unpaid criminal court fines, fees, or other charges, unless the applicant is on an arranged payment plan with a demonstrated compliance of at least one payment on that plan. Not out of compliance with any child support obligations.
 - (4) None of the denial criteria has been met.

The Motor Vehicle Dealer Board would like input to determine whether this criteria is still appropriate and if not what changes can be made to better serve the Mission of the Board.
