FINAL ORDER

IN RE: United Best Buy, Licensee/Respondent Wholesale Motor Vehicle Dealer License # 39832

This matter came before the Colorado Motor Vehicle Dealer Board (hereafter, the "Board"), on M a r c h 18, 2025, pursuant to C.R.S. §§ 44-20-104(3), 44-20-121, 24-4-104, and 24-4-105 (2022), and upon review of the Initial Decision Upon Default (hereafter, the "Initial Decision") for the Board, rendered by an Administrative Law Judge of the Office of Administrative Courts (hereafter, the "OAC") on December 18, 2024, in Case #BD24-0884 (hereafter, the "Case"). Prior to thirty (30) days after the Board served the Initial Decision on the Licensee/Respondent, the Board, through Delegation of Authority to the Board's Executive Secretary, extended its right to review the Initial Decision beyond the thirty (30) day limit.

The Board's review was confined to the Initial Decision immediately available for reference during the review.

The Board, having considered the Initial Decision, **HEREBY FINDS**, **DETERMINES**, **AND ORDERS THE FOLLOWING**:

FINDINGS

- 1. Based upon Respondent's failure to file a timely answer, an Entry of Default was issued on November 27, 2024, by an Administrative Law Judge of the Office of Administrative Courts.
- 2. The Administrative Law Judge believes revocation of the license is merited under the circumstances of the Case. Pursuant to the provisions of § 44-20-104(3)(m)(l)(A), C.R.S., an Administrative Law Judge may impose a fine of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for each offense. The Attorney General's Office alleged on behalf of the Board, one (1) count against Respondent and requested a fine in the amount of \$10,000. The Administrative Law Judge recommends that Respondent's motor vehicle dealer license be revoked and fined ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for each count.
- 3. The Board recognizes that Respondent failed to comply with the Stipulation pertaining to Cases BD16-1911, BD23-0303 and BD23-03034 and orders that the fine is no longer held in abeyance and is now due.
- 4. The Board served the Licensee/Respondent the Initial Decision on January 2, 2025, by United States Mail, first class postage prepaid.

- 5. The Board reasoned that it was appropriate to make the following determinations respective to the Initial Decision:
 - a. Accept the Findings of Fact;
 - b. Accept the Conclusions of Law/Analysis; and,
 - c. Accept the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order and Revoke the license.

DETERMINATIONS RESPECTIVE TO THE INITIAL DECISION

- 1. Accept the Findings of Fact in their entirety.
- 2. Accept the Conclusions of Law in their entirety.
- 3. Accept the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order.

ORDER

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, and pursuant to C.R.S. §§ 44-20-104(3), 44-20-121, 24-4-104, 24-4-104(11), and 24-4-105 (2022), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The Wholesale Motor Vehicle Dealer License #39832 of United Best Buy is Revoked and ordered to pay a fine of \$10,000.00. The Board also orders that the \$10,000 held in abeyance in the stipulation to cases BD16-1911, BD23-0303 and BD 23-0304 is due and payable. The Board also notes that the \$5,000 is due and payable from the initial stipulation for a total of \$25,000 due and payable. SO ORDERED this 18th day of March, 2025.
