### Security Waiver Request

**For this waiver request, please select from the options below (choose all that apply).**

- 3-220(A)(5)(a) - The entire Limited Access Area shall be surrounded by a fence constructed of nine gauge or lower metal chain link fence or another similarly secure material. The fence shall measure at least eight feet from the ground to the top, or in the alternative, the fence may measure six feet from the ground to the top with a 1 foot barbed wire arm with at least three strands along the entire fence. All support posts shall be steel and securely anchored.
- 3-220(A)(5)(b) - All gates of ingress or egress shall measure at least eight feet from the ground to the top of the entry gate, or in the alternative, the gate may measure six feet from the ground to the top with a 1 foot barbed wire arm with at least three strands, and shall be constructed of nine gauge or lower metal chain link fence or a similarly secure material.
- 3-220(A)(5)(c) - The fence shall obscure the Limited Access Area so that it is not easily viewed from outside the fence.
- 3-220(A)(5)(D) - All areas of ingress and egress of the fence shall be illuminated including a 20 foot radius from the point of ingress or egress. The required lights may be, but are not required to be, motion sensing. See also Rule 3-225(C).

**Approved security waivers expire at the same time as the underlying License.**

Applicants must provide required information for each security rule for which waiver is requested. Applicants are encouraged to attach supplemental and/or additional information (e.g. pictures, diagrams, construction plans, etc.) that the Division should consider in the review of the proposed alternative safeguard.
